

Bonsai Pot Size Chart



- The pot and tree must be proportional to one another, otherwise the pot will dominate the tree.
 A rule of thumb is that a pot's length should be two-thirds to three-quarters of the tree's height.
- Subtle and discrete ceramic glazes are suitable for some types of bonsai, especially flowering trees. However, the glazes must not dominate the plant.
- It is sometimes appropriate to plant flowering bonsai trees in colorful containers. However, it is usually more appropriate to use subdued and subtle colors.






This bonsai pot is generally ideal for rugged and heavy bonsai trees. For example evergreen conifers.



Unglazed small clay pot that compliments masculine bonsai trees.



Glazed medium sized circular pot that is mostly used for upright bonsai styles such as literati.




Unglazed large and deep clay pot that is ideal for large evergreen conifers.

RECTANGLE



Rectangular bonsai pots are also very common since it suits many bonsai styles.



A deep unglazed rectangular pot is suitable for heavy and large bonsai trees.



Glazed or unglazed pale grey pot is usually used for many deciduous bonsai trees.



unglazed shallow clay pot that is generally used for group bonsai styles.

OVAL



Oval bonsai pots can be used for both group and individual bonsai tree styles.




Off-white, shallow pale container ideal for individual or group planting of deciduous trees.



Colorful, medium-depth, oval bonsai pot is ideal for many flowering bonsai trees.



Unglazed, medium-depth, clay pot harmonizes well with evergreen conifer bonsai trees.



Deep, oval shaped bonsai pot is mostly used for bonsai trees with thick trunk.


CASCADE




Only used for cascade bonsai style.



Low-height, wide, square, deep and heavy cascade pot used for cascade bonsai trees that have long and spreading branches.



Medium-height, hexagonal cascade bonsai pot used for medium sized cascading bonsai trees.



Tall cascade bonsai pot that is generally used for cascade bonsai trees that do not have many spreading branches.
